The following are the COVID protocols for attending Feis Maitiú as of 24th January, 2022:

- 1. The maximum number at any event (including performers, supporters, adjudicator and staff) will be restricted to a maximum of 90 in our 300 seat auditorium.
- 2. Sanitizing stations will be available in the foyer, Green Room, stage, toilets and exit. The venue will be ventilated.
- 3. All Patrons are requested to be mindful of Social Distancing.
- 4. All those who are required to wear face masks, must do so.
- 5. Pianists and Accompanists are required to sanitise their hands both before and immediately after performance from the hand sanitiser on the Stage.
- 6. Each performer can be accompanied by four supporters only.
- 7. Performers are asked to arrive up to 10 minutes before starting time to complete check-in and to observe social distance. Performers who require costume, should arrive in costume. Changing facilities are not available.
- 8. Performers will sit with their supporters in the audience.
- 9. Performers will go directly to the stage from their seat when it is their turn; and return from the stage to their seat after the performance.
- 10. In classes of own choice, please bring printed paper copies of music and/or script. Do not put into plastic sheets or folders. Scripts and Music will not be returned. Please DO NOT bring original copies (for this year)
- 11. The usual awards will be made, but will not be physically presented by the Adjudicator.
- 12. In Classes with Cups or Trophies, winners can take photos with the Trophy on the stage, but cannot take the Trophy away.
- 13. We respectfully ask performers and supporters to leave immediately after the session, so that the Auditorium can be prepared and made ready for the next session.
- 14. There will be a one way system in operation, with the rule keep left.
- 15. Please help us have a safe and happy Feis for all involved.
- 16. Admission fee €4.00, concessions are available.
